Watching for Wildlife on the Trail

Animals are not easy to find on the trail. Unlike trees and plants, they hear and smell us coming and hide! For the best results when searching for animals on the trail, be quiet and watch carefully. Animals tend to be camouflaged and will stay still until you pass. Being quiet and observant is the only way to see the animals that are there. Test your observational skill. Identify the following things on the forest floor below. Find the chipmunk, mouse, snail, newt, spotted salamander, toad, earthworm, 7 mushrooms, trillium wildflower, whole acorn, acorn cap, 2 maple seeds, 6 hemlock pine cones, 4 ants and a slug.
